INTRODUCTIONS AND WELCOME

Debbie Sarmiento welcomed everyone and everyone introduced themselves. The committee discussed the ICC Primary Focus for Planning Period Beginning 2009/2010: Child and Family Outcomes document.

The Committee identified the work plan for the year November 2009 thru November 2010 would include the following tasks:

1. Input regarding Family Survey for APR
2. Analyze implications of child and family outcome data
3. Strategies to ensure parental right as identified by APR

The committee agreed that they will work on the above tasks with the focus on Indicators #3 and #4 (listed below).

Indicator #3: Communication/Cognitive, Self Help and Social Emotional.
Percent of infants and toddlers with IFSPs who demonstrate: positive social-emotional skills, acquisition and use of knowledge and skills; use of appropriate behaviors to meet their needs.

Indicator #4: Understand rights, better able to enhance the dev of their child,
Percent of families participating in Part C who report that early intervention services helped the family: know their rights; effectively communicate their children's needs; and help their children develop and learn.
