- B. Discussion about Prevention Program
- Former member cautioned that tasks 4 and 5 are under the purview of regional centers, not the responsibility of ICC.
 - PPP is a separate RC program not under Lanterman and not under ES. Some SELPAs are determining that they will serve at-risk children, some are not.
 - **Priority of ICC and the committee is to address ES issues. Prevention Program is secondary.**
 - May want to send a message to ARCA urging them to consider ICC issues/concerns about PPP.
