
This will open a file download window, choose the open option:




Double click on the installer:




You will get this security warning window, choose the run option:



You be asked if you are sure you want to add to the registry, choose yes:




The you see this screen that confirm the registry was updated




Click ok and return to <https://even.dds.ca.gov> to continue installation of Citrix.


After installing the CertIE6.reg (if you're using Internet Explorer 6), or CertIE7.reg (if your browser is Internet Explorer 7) found on the ast website, enter <https://even.dds.ca.gov> on your browser address line. 
If you see the alert in the Message Center indicating the appropriate client software has not been detected, click on the link to obtain it:




Click on the Download button:



When prompted for the file download, click the Run button:




