SSIP: Broad Improvement Strategies

California will implement the following broad improvement strategies in order to address the State-identified Measurable Result of increasing the percentage of infants and toddlers with IFSPs exiting Early Start who substantially increased their rate of growth in social-emotional development.

- 1. Develop and implement sustainable **outreach**, education, and training strategies **through the Early Start Comprehensive System of Personnel Development (ES CSPD)** for entire Early Start Community, including families and community members working with children, on Early Start **effective** practices and family-centered philosophy **as presented in the Early Start Personnel Manual and competencies (ESPM)**, as recommended by ICC.
 - (a) **Promote** and implement sustainable, evidence-based training strategies for entire Early Start Community on social and emotional development and parent-child relationships.
 - (b) Leverage effective practices of regional centers and LEAs or other entities in engaging families in the social/emotional development of the child through enhanced parent-child relationship.
- 2. Identify and partner with interagency collaboratives to disseminate information on the importance of parent-child relationships and social/emotional development with the State Interagency Coordination Council as the lead.
- 3. Identify evidence-based measurement tools and procedures to better document progress in child outcomes in social/emotional development.
