## Chapter 2 - Early Intervention Services SubChapter 2 - Program and Service Components Article 2 - Evaluation and Assessment

§52086. Time Lines for Completion of Evaluation and Assessment.

- a) Except as provided in subsection (b), the initial evaluation <u>for eligibility</u> and <u>child and family</u> assessments <u>and the initial IFSP meeting</u> for eligibility for each infant or toddler shall be completed within 45 days of the date that the regional center or LEA received the referral.
- (b) In the event of exceptional <u>family</u> circumstances <u>or lack of parent consent for the initial evaluation and assessment (despite documented repeated attempts to obtain consent)</u>, which make it impossible to complete the initial evaluation <u>for eligibility</u>, and assessments <u>for eligibility</u> (<u>child and family</u>), and <u>IFSP meeting</u> within 45 days of receiving a referral, the service coordinator shall:
- (1) Document the exceptional <u>family</u> circumstances <u>or lack of consent</u> in the infant's or toddler's record;
- (2) Inform the parent of the reasons for the delay:
- (32) Inform the parent of an alternative time line which includes a specific date for eCompleting the evaluation and assessment as soon as possible after the documented exceptional family circumstances no longer exist or parental consent is obtained.; and, (4) Document that the parent has been informed and is in agreement with the reasons documented for the extension beyond 45 days.
- (c) If an infant or toddler has been determined eligible but the assessment required in Section 52082 has not been completed within 45 days of receiving a referral because of exceptional family circumstances, the service coordinator shall:
- (1) Document the exceptional <u>family</u> circumstances in the infant's or toddler's record; (2) <u>Inform the parent of the reasons for the delay:</u>
- (32) Develop an interim IFSP pursuant to Section 52107 of these regulations; and,
- (43) Provide the services agreed upon in the interim IFSP.
