

Beginning January 1, 1993, Senate Bill 1383 (McCorquodale) required the Department of Developmental Services (Department) to enter into five-year outcome-based performance contracts with regional centers. The information that was gathered by the Department and the regional centers from the initial data led to an interest in refining the manner in which system and individual outcomes were established and then measured. The current Performance Contract brings about the idea of establishing a comprehensive performance-based system of accountability for all those who serve consumers and their families.

Outcome-based performance plans must be developed through meaningful participation with each regional center's local community. The community is essential to help the regional center prioritize the performance areas and possible outcomes for the people that they serve. In order to insure involvement, regional centers must conduct at least one public meeting, collect information from the community through focus groups or surveys, and solicit feedback whenever possible on the services and supports available.

# Evaluation Criteria for Regional Center Performance

- The Department reviews baseline and year-end information to evaluate performance. Success is demonstrated when:
- The outcome has improved over the prior year's baseline, or
- The performance exceeds the statewide average, or
- The performance equals a standard that has been defined by the Department
