It has been identified additional vehicles are needed to support additional community integration and small vehicles are preferred by the clients in order to support inclusion and smaller group activities. Additionally, staff training is needed within the areas of communication strategies, person centered planning and HCBS compliance, we anticipate a one year contracted consultant can assist with the teaching and dissemination of HCBS guidelines to staff, families and clients as well as provide additional training and support on the above mentioned topics to assist with compliance.

This consultant will be in charge of ensure compliance of all guidelines oversee the budget and spending of funds if granted, and conducting audits of current systems and modify as necessary to be in compliance.
