# We're changing some rules to help you stay safe.

These changes will give regional centers more ways to help you.

# What's changing

## **Home Provider Payments and Rates**

- Regional Centers can pay your home provider extra money during COVID-19 to keep you healthy and safe where you live.
- If you need to move somewhere else for a little while because you're sick or might get sick, your regional center can keep paying your home provider while you're gone.

# **Deadlines for Regional Center Staff:**

 Some work that is not related to health and safety is being postponed. This will give regional centers more time to focus on you.

# **Enhanced Behavioral Supports Homes & Community Crisis Homes:**

- Staff in these homes can continue to support you when they do not have certain certifications.
- This is being done to increase the number of staff that are available to support you.

# Competitive Integrated Employment Incentive Payments Program:

 If you are part of this program and have to stop working because of COVID-19, it won't count as a break from your job if you go back to work at the same place after COVID-19.

### **Parental Fees:**

- During this crisis, parents will not be required to begin paying a fee if they need to place their minor child in a licensed residential home.
- This will reduce regional center staff workload and help lessen financial concerns for some families.
