Important notice from the Department of Developmental Services about Reporting Incidents Related to COVID-19

What to know

Regional centers and people who support you report to DDS if someone is sick or dies from COVID-19.

During the COVID-19 outbreak, regional centers and providers will complete a report for some incidents related to COVID-19. This will help your staff know if there is a risk to you or others and will help keep you safe.

What's changing

Regional centers and providers will complete a report if:

- You have COVID-19
- You go to a doctor because you might have COVID-19
- Someone dies from COVID-19

This information will be used to help make plans to keep you and others safe during the COVID-19 crisis.
