# Community Engagement



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- Began planning in late February for the “what if” possibility of not being able to leave our homes.
- Analyzed all services to determine what we could possibly deliver at a distance.

## Sample Schedule

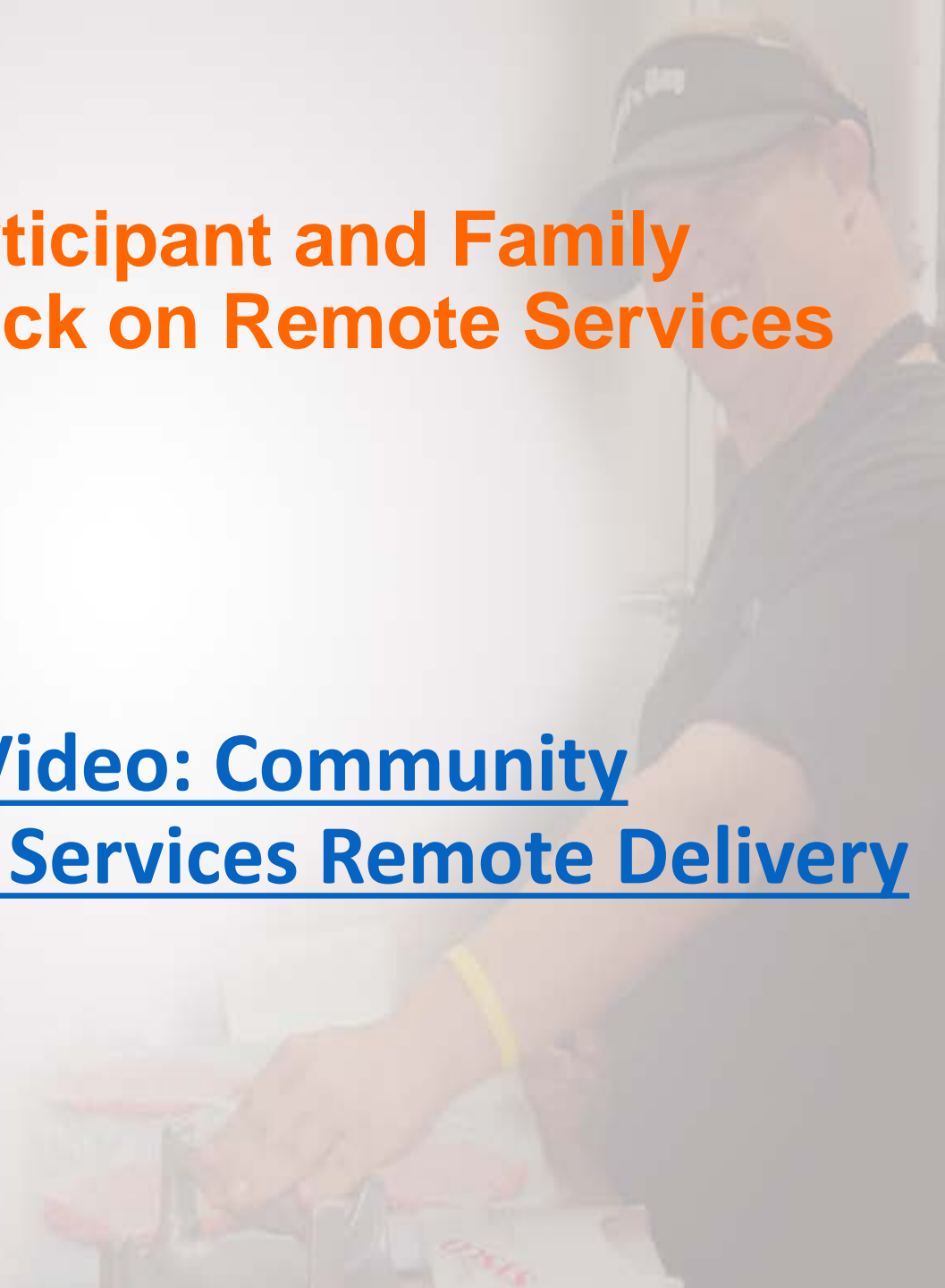
- **Daily Check-In:** Ask participants what they desire to learn, and ask about post-crisis goals and what they want to learn while at home.
- **Personal Care:** Hygiene
- **Cognitive Development Activities:** Scavenger hunt, pattern repetition and memory games.
- **Arts & Enrichment Activities:** Virtual tours of museums, art activities (digital and/or physical).
- **Communication:** Literacy skills, budgeting, and resume writing.
