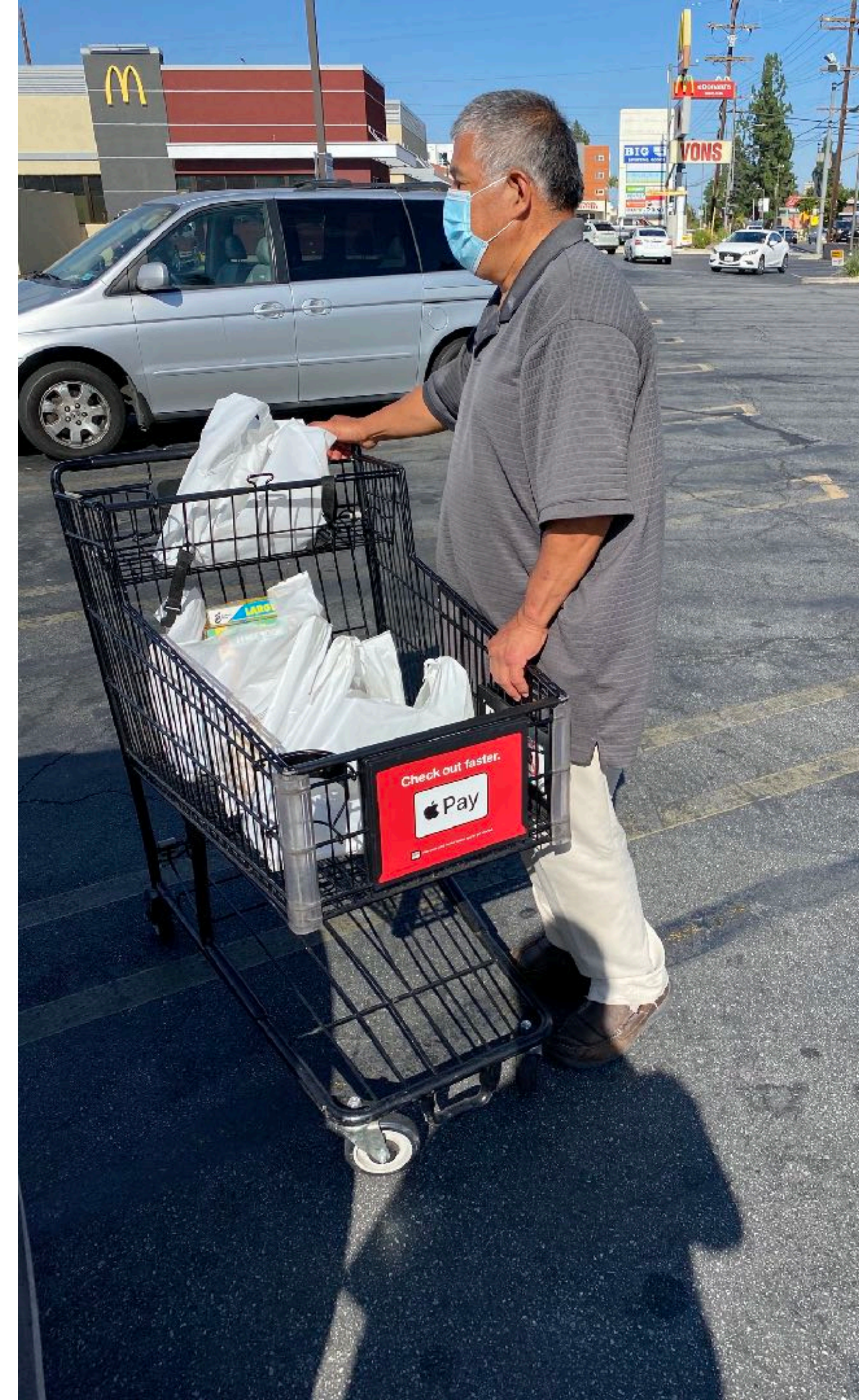

- I am completing First Aid and CPR Training online with David Shepard

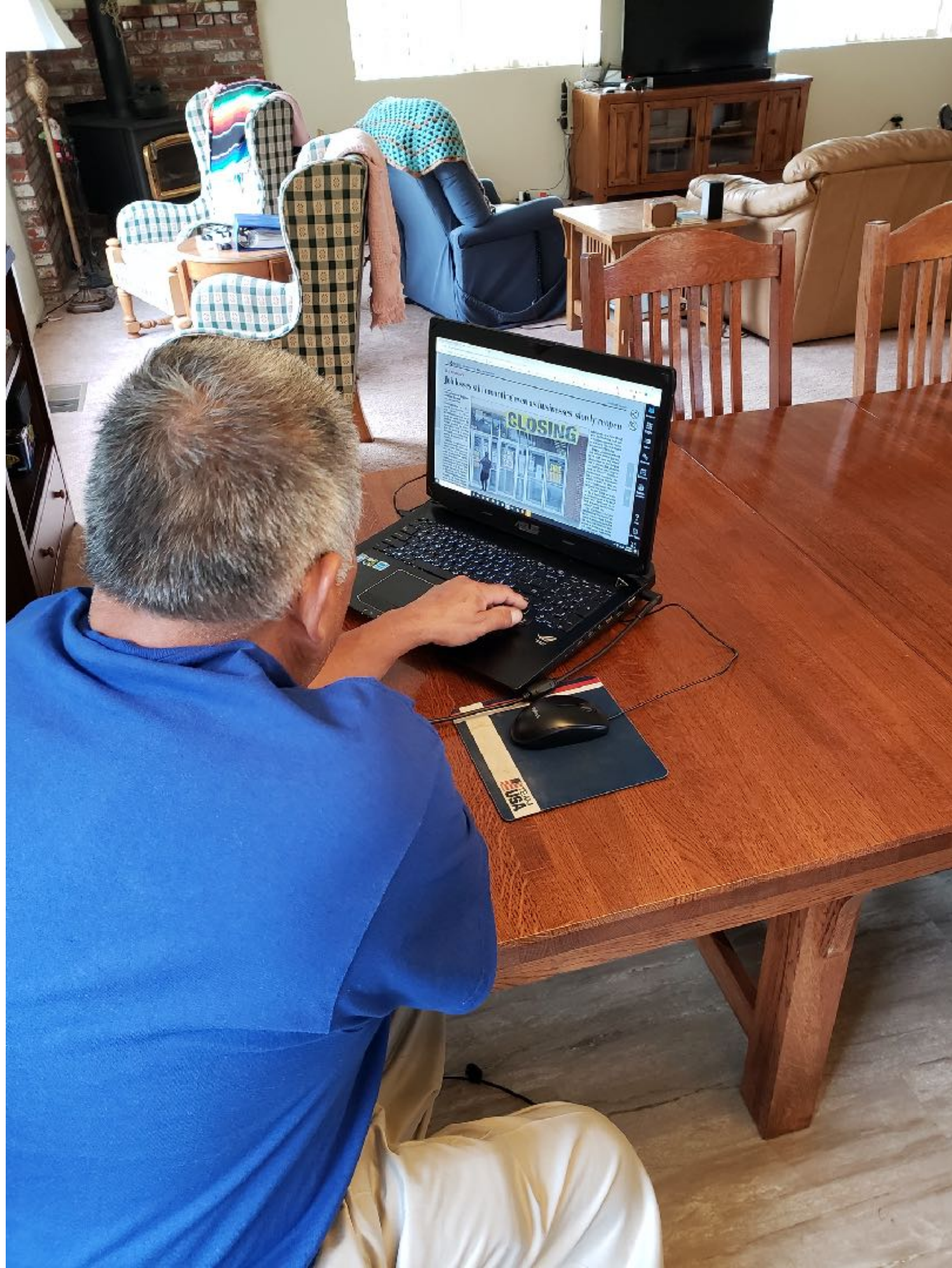
I got to present on 3 webinars in April

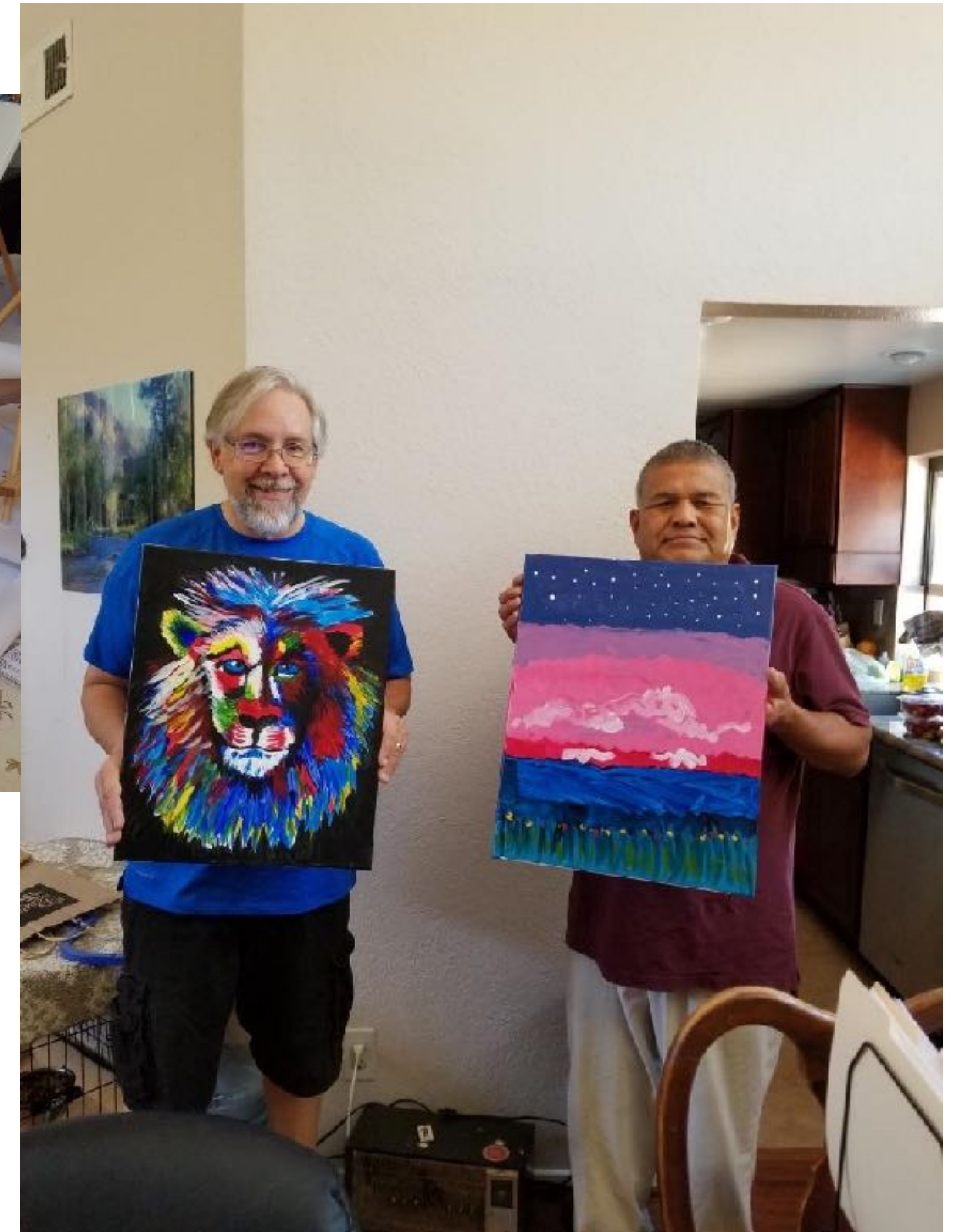

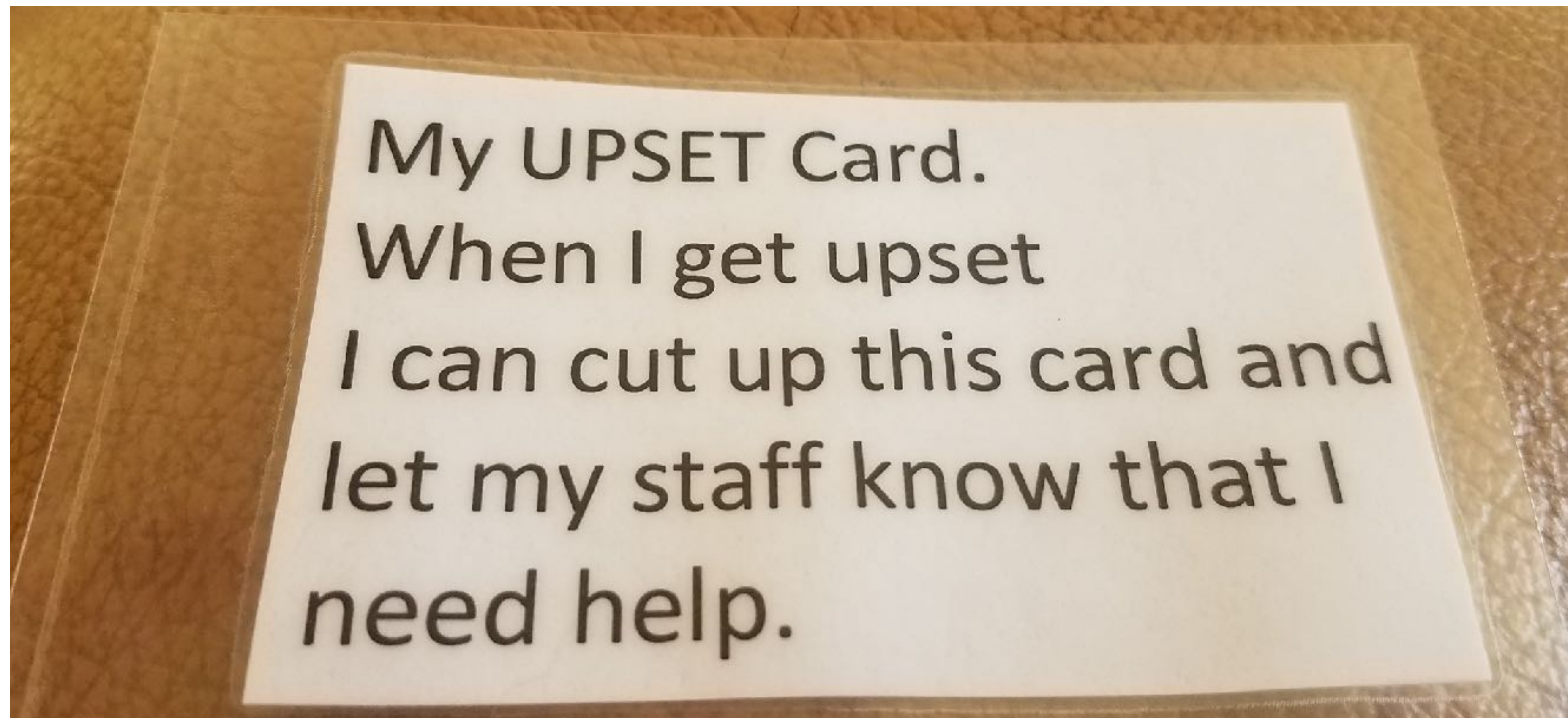
