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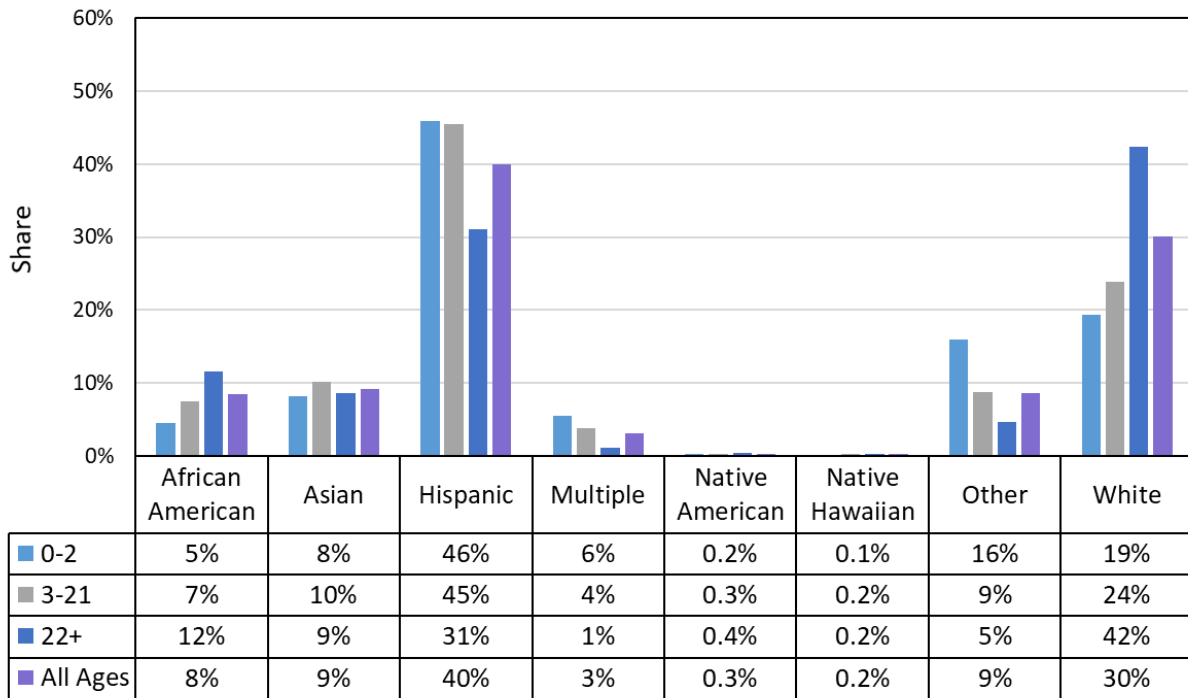
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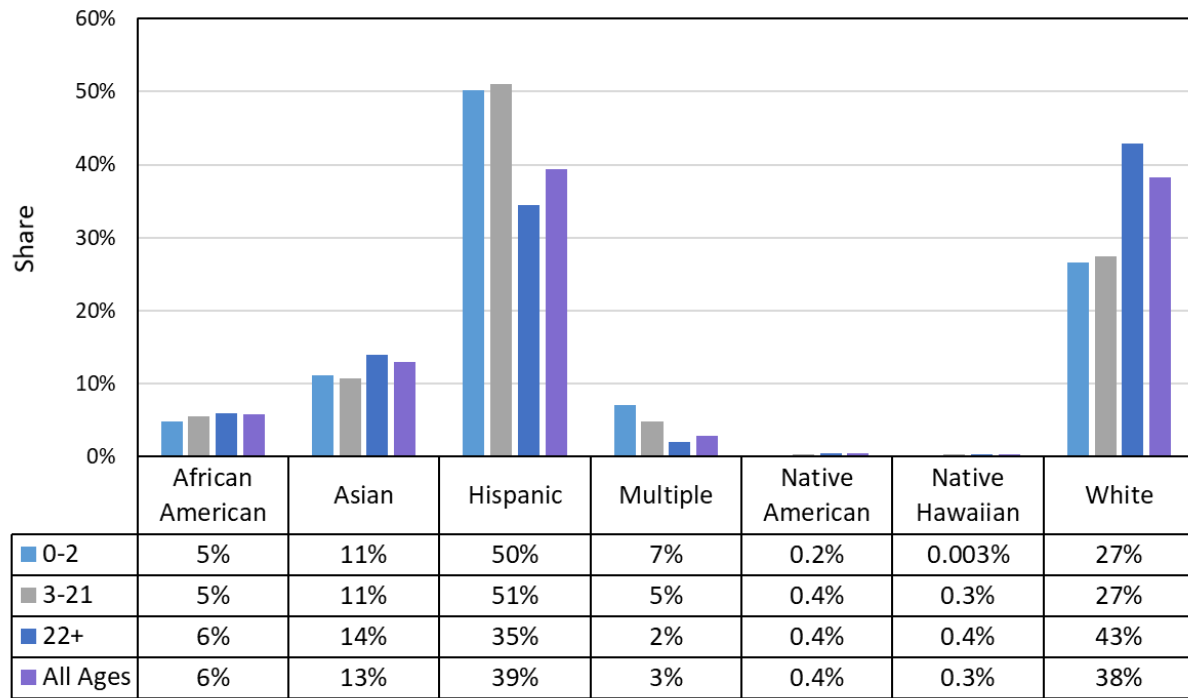

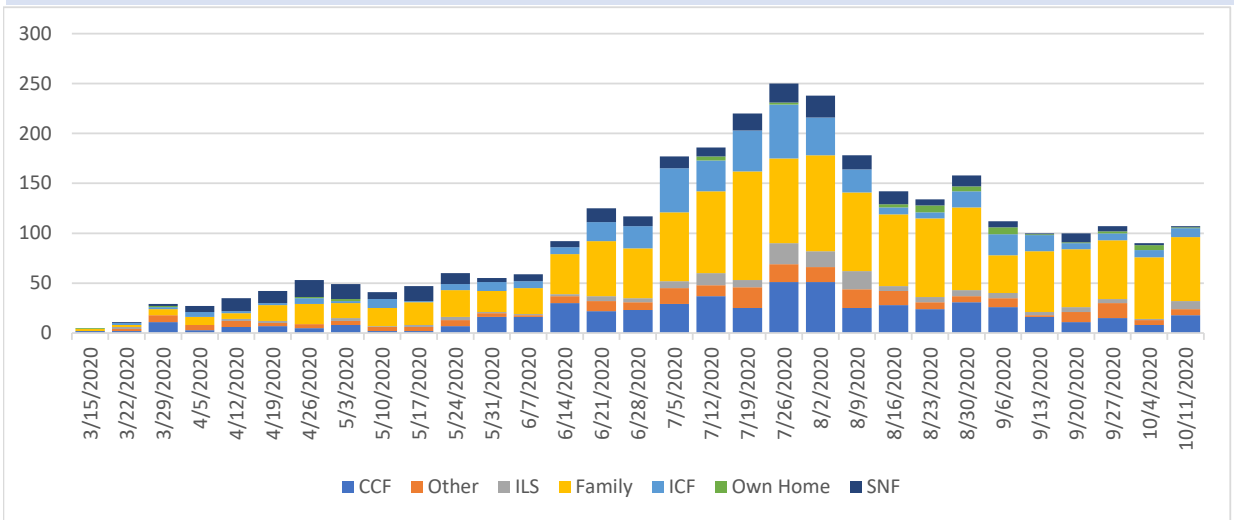
**Figure 1. Number of consumers newly reported as COVID-19 positive, by week**

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**Figure 1. Share of Statewide Consumers by Ethnicity and Age Group for Fiscal Year 2018/19**

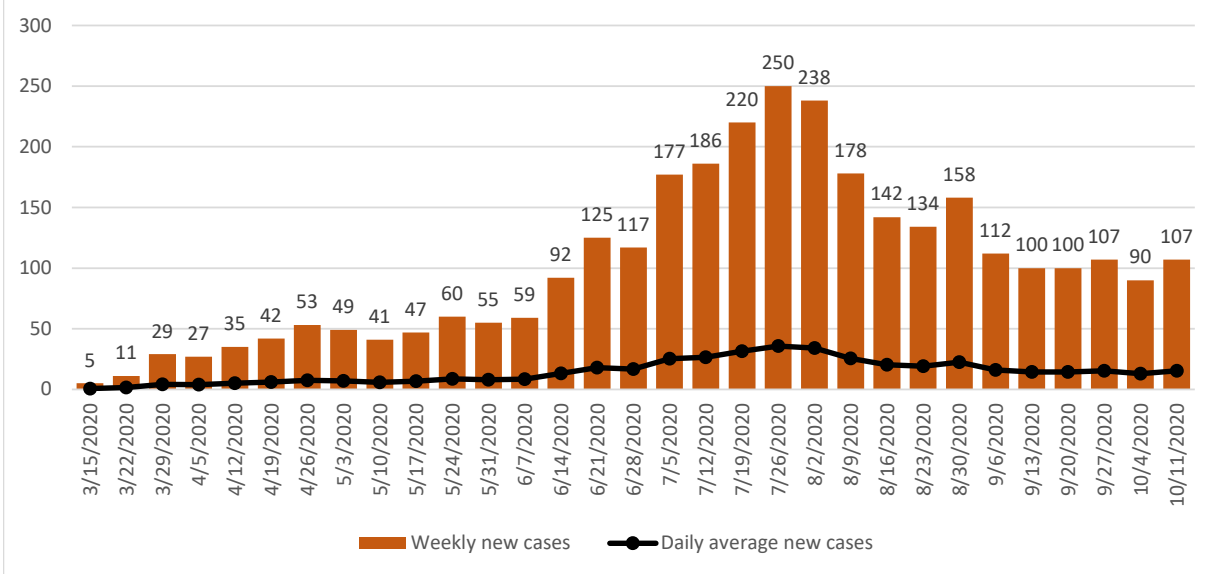

Figure 5. Number of infants/toddlers in Early Start Intake/Assessment

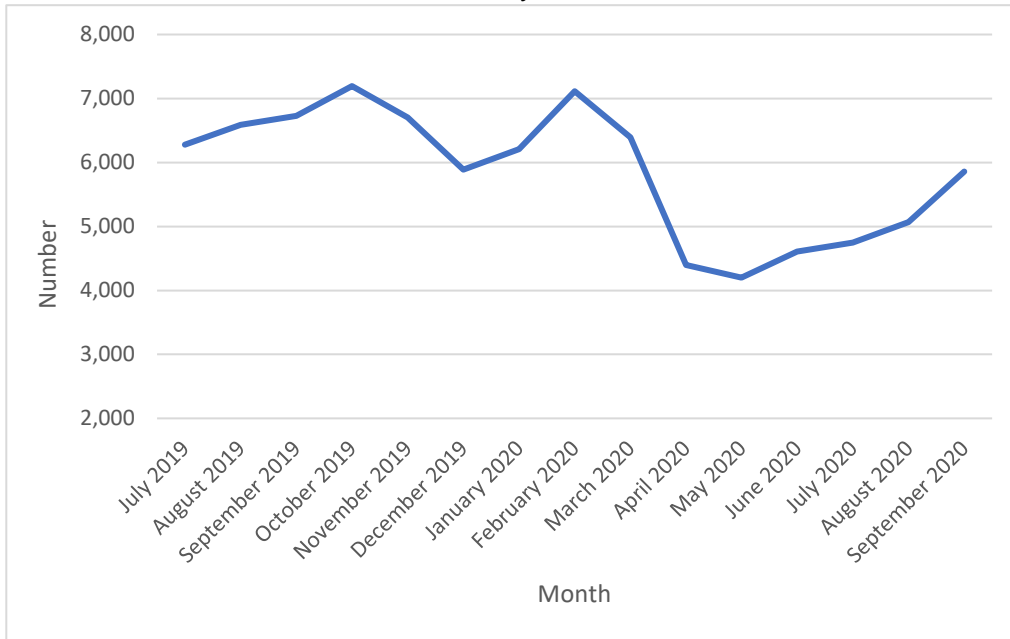
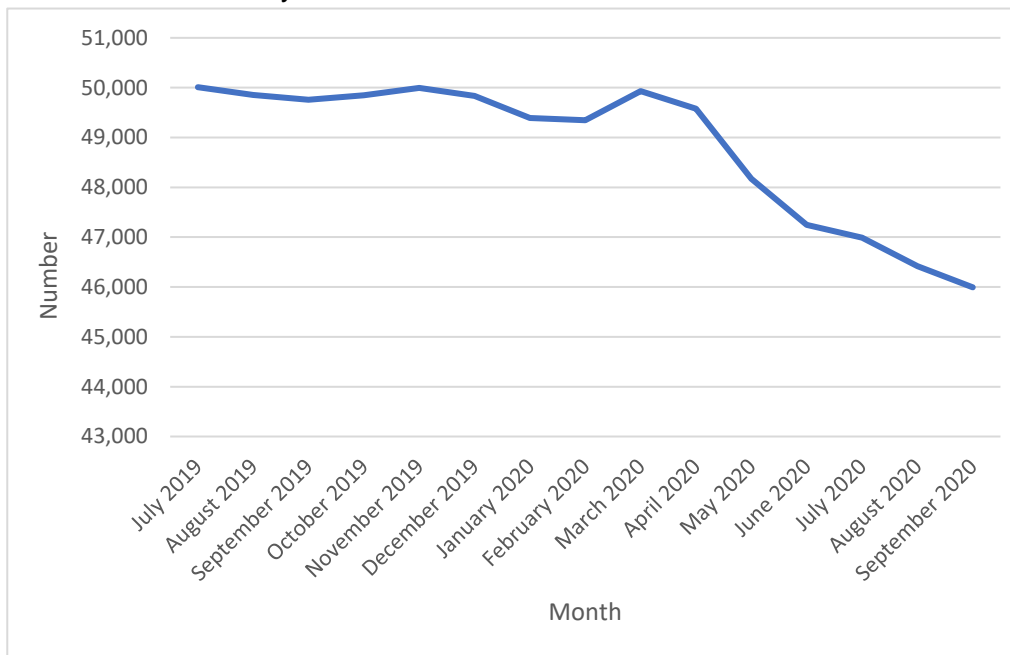


Figure 6. Number of Early Start consumers
