





Figure 1. Number of consumers newly reported as COVID-19 positive, by week




Figure 2. Number of consumers newly reported as COVID-19 positive, by week and residence type

Number of Infants/Toddlers in Early Start Intake/Assessment and Number of Early Start Consumers, July 2019 through September 2020





Figure 5. Number of infants/toddlers in Early Start Intake/Assessment
