Annual State Budget Process

"Governor's Budget" By January 10th

DDS builds budgets for RC Operations, POS & policy proposals, based on prior years' actual caseloads & costs

Governor proposes the budget that starts July 1 & updates the current year budget

Budget Hearings

"May Revision" By May 15th

DDS **updates budgets** for RC Operations, POS & policy proposals, based on more recent caseloads & costs

Governor updates budget proposals related to caseload and enrollment

Budget Hearings

By June 15th

Based on public input and legislative priorities, Legislature may include other budget proposals

"Conference Committee" resolves differences in Senate & Assembly budget bills, with State Leaders

Legislature submits budget for Governor's signature

On July 1st

State Fiscal Year begins

Budget Act & Trailer Bills give DDS authority to implement the signed budget

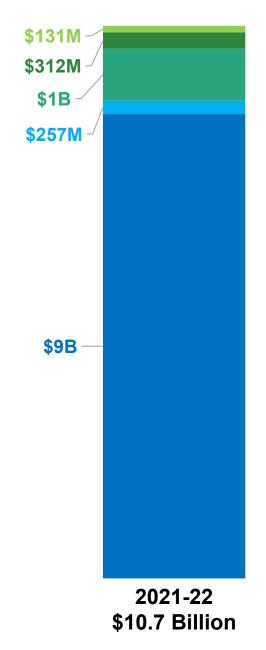

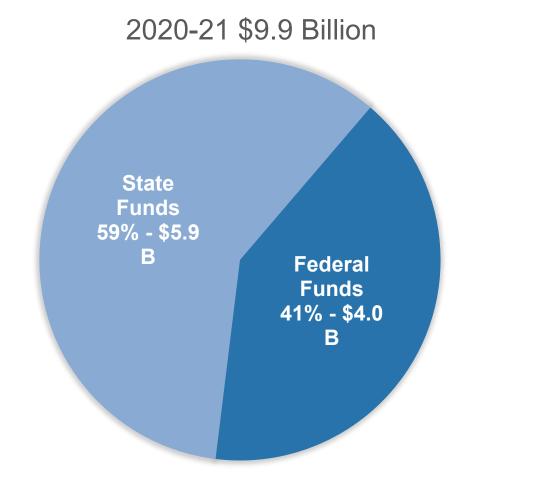

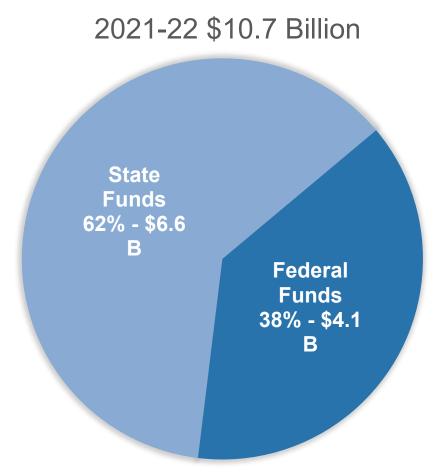

Assumes pre-pandemic caseload growth patterns based on targeted outreach & provisional eligibility

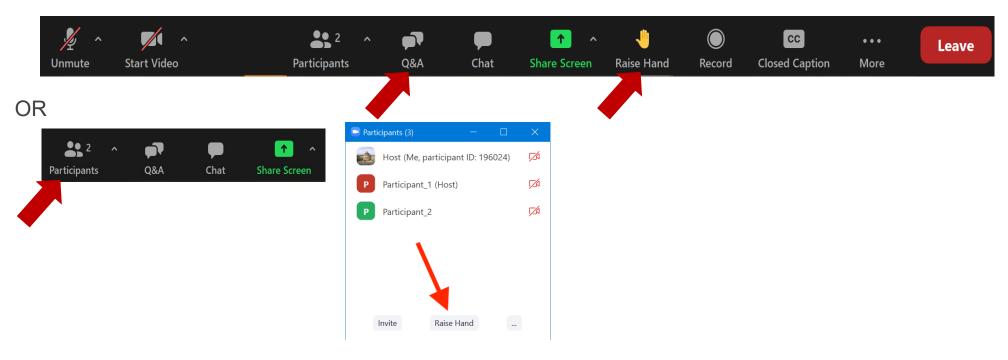
