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RECOMMENDATIONS

During the monitoring review, the Department of Developmental Services (DDS) reviewed multiple records where:

- written consent was not found, nor was there any documentation of efforts made to obtain written consent prior to the provision of services;
- notification/referrals to LEAs were only submitted when parental consent was obtained; and,
- steps and services in the transition plan contained generic or canned language

Considering what is outlined above, DDS recommends the following to be implemented for FDLRC to operate in compliance with state and federal regulations, as well as to better serve the needs of children and families in the Early Start system:

- Align practices/procedures related to obtaining written consent as required per Title 34, CFR §§303.342(e) and 303.7(b), FDLRC shall:
 - o make all efforts to obtain written consent prior to provision of early start services; and,
 - o under circumstances where written consent cannot be obtained, document in the child's record all attempts made to obtain written consent and any exceptional family circumstance (EFC) that may exist.
- Align practices/procedures related to transition as required per Title 34, CFR §303.209, and Title 34, CFR §303.344 (h), FDLRC shall:
 - o ensure notification/referrals to Local Education Agencies meet regulatory requirements; and,
 - o ensure transition plans in each IFSP include individualized steps and services that support a smooth transition for the child and address the family's concerns and priorities.
