



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

What is the base wage file?

- Let's start with "base wage"
 - Earnings from base period used to establish eligibility and benefits for Unemployment Insurance
- Employers report these earnings quarterly
- Database of person-earnings



- UI Covered employees' wages
- Major Exclusions
 - Sole proprietors and unincorporated self-employed
 - Some agricultural and domestic employees
 - Workers with no wages during entire quarter


How do we know industry?

- Employers report industry activity, when registering with UI
- LMID Employer Classification Unit classifies employers based on response and supplemental information if needed
- Employers are assigned a NAICS code corresponding to classification
- Employers verify, update or change on a 3 year basis

- Industry classification provides a consistent identifying structure.
- The system provides basic terms to study the structure of an area's business composition.
- Identifying the industry structure defines the unique features of an area's economy.

Products and Resources

Geographic Information System: Maps and reports displaying labor market data, patterns, and trends.

Ad Hoc Reports: Customized reports utilizing various EDD administrative data sources.

Business Employment and Wages: Comprehensive tabulations of employment and wage information for workers covered by California Unemployment Insurance laws.

Occupational Employment and Wages: Employment and wage estimates for over 800 occupations.

Employment Projections: Estimates of change in industry and occupational employment resulting from industry growth, exits, and transfers.

Occupational Guides: Detailed information on wages, job outlook, education, and licensing requirements for approximately 300 occupations.






DISTRIBUTION OF CONSUMERS BY QUARTER WAGES 2019 Q4 & 2020 Q4




AVERAGE QUARTERLY WAGE OF REGIONAL CENTER (RC) CONSUMERS, BY QUARTER & ETHNICITY




NUMBER OF CONSUMERS WITH WAGES, BY QUARTER & ETHNICITY




NUMBER OF CONSUMERS WITH WAGES, 2019 Q4 AND 2020 Q4






