The prect will address some of the most ommine assons why tibal ommunities are underserved by the egional enter (e.g. lack f ultu al ompeten y and knowledge of t ibal government inf ast u tu e and u al settings); additionally, the p ect will als address some of the most omm n easons why tibal families are less likely t ac ess servi es f om the egional enters (e.g. lack of awareness, stigma, fear, and es u es). The ect Di ect is Maidu and aiute and a member of the Susanville Indian Ran heria in N them Calif nia. The ect Di ect has w ked as a tibal s ial servi es di ect and ICWA ou tadv ate f the past 12 years, and u ently serves as the development di ect f Calif nia Tibal Families Coalition, is a ommunity leader f Tibal Star and Tibal Justi e Systems Collaborative, and a delegate at Offi e of Tibal Affai s, Having an established elati nship f trust with ti al mmunities is the key to ultivating hange in the ommunity's awareness and understanding of intellectual and development disabilities. Harley's Hope will dinate out each events and invite the SDR & IR Centers t parti ipate. The engagement eff ts will utilize the pr ect di ect 's personal experien e of having a hild with a developmental and intellectual disability and will share the family's ou ney of dis overing and ac essing se vices f om the egional enter. This meth dol ogy is specifi ally ultu ally ompetent t use with t ibal ommunities because st ytelling has t aditionally been the way u people have shared thei hist y and knowledge with others and futu e generations. St ytelling is a powerful way t engage native families and it is the p ect's hope that by sharing their own personal our neys of understanding and accepting their hild's diagnosis; that it will help remove some of the barries to accessing servi es and it will in ease awareness f egional enters and the life changing se vices they can p vide f thei I ved nes.

This sad fa t goes unn ti ed y the maj ity fmy fell wt ibal families & t ibal mmunities I w k with. The t uth is, there a e a large number ft ibal f lks wh have n idea that RC's exist, & e tainly don't know what thei fun ti n is. I know this, because I too was in this ategory only three short years ago. The most astonishing thing about my ign an e, is that as a die t of as ial servi es depa tment f one f the biggest t ibes in S uthen Calif nia, & unning ne of the most high p file s ial se vi e p ograms in the state, I had neve been ntacted y the RC f any pu pose. My dis ve y of the RC ame about f ma physi ally therapist I was taking my daughte t see at Rady's Children's H spital. It was though my dis ussions with he, that she informed me about the RC & ecommended I all them d as eening f Ha ley. It was this moment that stated u ou ney f dis ve y of the RC & what they do. It is hard to include my peers in the design because they simply don't ealize what the p oblem is exactly; they ust know they have unmet needs & lack fesures f theis special needs munities. This fact tells me outreach is needed in tribal mmunities & education is needed by RC's and tribes.
