It sh uld be n ted that K eans $0-2$ are underutilizing the se vi es, and that the e a elatively I w numbe of $K$ eans egistered in the RC system. Considering the prevalen e f devel pmental delays ( 1 in 6 ) in the gene al population and the number fK ean Ameri ans in $u$ at hment area $(324,000 \mathrm{~K}$ eans ac ding LA Times, 2020) we should expect to see highe numbe s egiste ed. This is espe ially imp tant in <br> nsidering that early dis ve $y$ and early interventi $n$ is esea hed to be the most effe tive at this age but the data shows underutilizati $n$. It is speculated (based nou foll $w$ up data fr $m$ pa ents of simila age g up ) that the e is la k frealizati n n the imp tan e fearly interventi n and/ parents a e "waiting it out" because they have mis on eptualized understanding f hild devel pment (e.g., due to a pa ent's wn developmental milestone that was a hieved late ).
