The objective of our prectise to provide fee developmental seenings fhildren (ages 5 and under) within the Kean Ameian ommunities of Los Angeles and Orange Cunties. The purpese of the seenings is to identify developmental delays and prmote access to servies though RCs and shool systems. Our pet will als consist of outrean (e.g., eduating the community about the impetance of early seening and intervention) and follow-up servies fhildren with developmental delays, all provided in the Kean language and with onsideration of Kean ultue.

KASEC has p vided f ee developmental s eenings sin e 2012. As of date, it has s eened over 1,200 hildren ages 5 and under. Half were s eened with the help of DDS Disparity G ants (2017-2018, 2018-2019, 2020-2021). A total of 284 efer als have been made, with over 100 efer als to I al egional enters. This is especially important in sidering that early discovery early intervention is eseaned to be the most effective at this age but the data shows underutilization. It is speculated (based nou follow up data from parents of similar age group) that the eight as frealization in the importance of early intervention and/parents are "waiting it out" because they have mis on eptualized understanding of hild development (e.g., due to a parent's windevelopmental milestone that was a hieved late). Further, in the K ean ulture, being identified as developmentally delayed is heavily stigmatized, which makes assessments and services unfavorable.
