We serve a ultu allydiverse population with high needs (e.g. signi i ant incidence Fetal Al ohol Syndrome, pre-natal txi exposure to meth, repeated years in whi h the area has experienced Federally Declared Natural Disasters-Fire and Fl d). Infants, toddlers and young hildren are parti ularly disadvantaged by p 1 y devel ped healthcare, educational and amily es urc es. C1 laborative partnerships to provide a strong network support in ur 1 al area are parti ularly needed, as individuals may be several hours away rom more populated and better es urc ed towns and itles. RCRCs at h ment area includes a signi i ant Native Ameri an populati n. Development and delivery ulturally appropriate services and approaches to serve this ommunity has been a barrier. This grant will a littate, int oduce and expand services and supports which utilize the st engths and honor the traditions that are unique to this population.
