The $f$ llowing seven activities provide the necessary steps to hi e (1) one full-time and (1) one part-time staff who will p vide the sessions to the self-adv ate parti ipants. Staff will be hired and trained in the fi st month of the grant cycle. Then, beginning Mar h 1, 2022, staff will begin c ntac ting refer als received from CVRC with the aim of establishing s hedule for in-home, vi tual, or in- ommunity sessions. If a community site is not secured in time for parti ipants who desi e to trained in a community site, they will be given the option to get started with one of the other tw opti ons and then booked ac dingly nc e the community site becomes available. Activity numbe th ee will also be af cus while ec uiting, hi ing, and training to insure the pr ect has the appropriate technology for those self-adv ate parti ipants that desi e vi tual training. This budget includes hi ing full and part-time personnel who bring the lived experience, educati nal edentials, community c nnec tions, and cultural awareness and sensitivity to the focus populations being served. The pr ect di ector is the founder and CEO of Jewel of Justi e and will devote $25 \% \mathrm{f}$ time in leading this innovative and CVRC supported pr ect. Although the pr ect is starting within the greater F esno area initially, we plan to expand to reach $m$ e rural areas in a next funding cycle upon vendor approval. The training will $p$ vide selfadv ate parti ipants with the materials, tools, res ur es, and content to speak up for themselves, and others, as well as build str ng community and cultural nnec tions in becoming $m$ e confident and independent.
