RCOC has identified Asian Afi an-Ame $i$ an and Hispani as ta get populations $f$ utrea h. As f October 2021, RCOC se ved 4277 Asian individuals in both Ea ly Sta t and Lante man p g ams ( $18.5 \%$ of total pe s ns se ved). C mpa ing the $u$ ent data with data fr m past yea s, RCOC had only served about 13\% Asian populati n in 2017, and $17.3 \%$ Asian populati $n$ in 2019. We have made s mep gess th ugh u Child Find a tivities, h weve, new 2020 ensus data will meout s nhi h will undoubtedly indi ate an even la ger Asian population in OC (preliminary ensus data indi ates $21.7 \% \mathrm{f}$ OC is $\mathrm{n} w$ Asian), and the g al of out ea h within the Asian mmunity is to ensu e that families a e awa e and able to a ess Regi nal Cente se vi es. The stigma on disabilities and ultu al diffe en es eates bar ierst a essing needed se vi es. Devel pmental s eenings inl al neighb $h$ ds with bilingual staff and/o inte $p$ ete $s$ on-site will in ease the pp tunity fo families to bring thei hild $t$ a developmental seening and obtain needed se vi es. Staff fr mRCOC a e always p esent at the $s$ eening site to assist families with the intake $p$ ess fo Ea ly Sta $t$ and $P$ visi nal Lante man g ams. This initial nta t als helps to ensu e that families and individuals with intelle tual and developmental disabilities kn w about $R C O C$ as well as whe $e$ and $w h \quad t$ onta $t$ if needed in the futu $e$. |  |
