**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
Children's Community Crisis Homes and
Enhanced Behavior Supports Homes Regulations**

Notice is hereby given that the Department of Developmental Services (Department) will conduct a virtual public hearing at the time and place noted below to consider amendments to the Children's Community Crisis Homes (CCH) and Enhanced Behavior Supports Homes (EBSH) regulations. The proposed rulemaking action is described in the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking and Public Comment Period for Proposed Amendments (Notice) which was previously distributed and published in the [California Regulatory Notice Register](#) (Notice File No. Z-2022-0524-07) and [posted on the Department's Internet Web Site on June 3, 2022](#).
