



- Monthly meetings to collaborate and share resources




- Create community partnerships for learning & advocacy

- Improve access to culturally and linguistically responsive behavioral health services and crisis intervention




#### **Competitive Integrated Employment - by Ethnicity**



# Paid Internship Program (PIP) - by Ethnicity




# Working Age Consumers – by Ethnicity


