ACRONYMS

CAST

- **Crisis Assessment Stabilization Teams (CAST)**
- State-operated mobile crisis services

CCH

- **Community Crisis Homes (CCH)**
- Residential facilities that provide 24-hour non-medical care to adults & children w/ developmental disabilities (DD) in need of crisis intervention services

HDO

- **Housing Developer Organization (HDO)**
- “Buy It Once” model where the HDO owns the property for the restricted use by regional center consumers.

IMD

- **Institutions for Mental Disease (IMD)**
- Residential facilities with 16 or more beds used to treat mental illness & receive medical/ nursing care; considered a highly restrictive setting

PDC-STP

- **Porterville Developmental Center (PDC) Secure Treatment Program (STP)**
- The STP serves individuals who are committed for placement through the criminal justice system.

STAR Homes

- **Stabilization Training Assistance Reintegration (STAR)**
- Serves children/adolescents (7-17 yrs old) & adults (18+ yrs old) receiving regional center services in need of time-limited crisis stabilization services for up to 13 months

START Program

- **Systemic, Therapeutic, Assessment, Resources and Treatment (START)**
- Serves individuals aged 6+ residing in-home & out-of-home w/person-centered, trauma-informed, evidence-based, positive supports

DE/SP Homes

- **Delayed Egress Secured Perimeter (DE/SP)**
- For consumers determined to require enhancement to staff supervision with delayed egress devices & secured perimeters (locked fence/gate around the home)

Expand Acute Crisis Options:

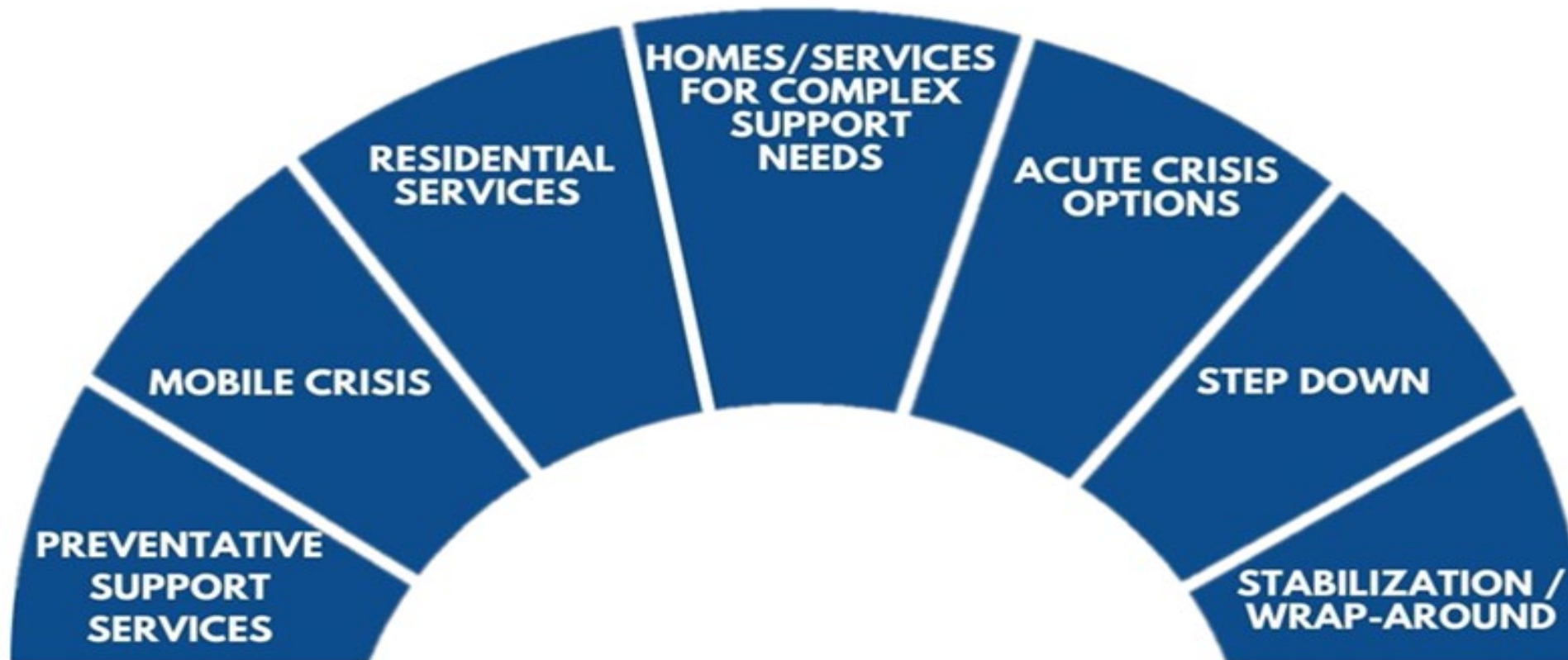
- Northern STAR
 - Increase capacity by another 4 beds (currently 10 beds)
 - HDO development of 3 community homes (up to 14 beds)
- South STAR
 - Capacity of 10 beds
 - HDO development of 2 homes on Mark Lane (10 beds)
- CAST- 3 Acute Crisis Teams

Increase options to serve individuals with the most challenging service needs:

- PDC-STP Step down Transition Homes (3 homes, 15 beds)
- PDC-STP Intensive Transition Support Services
- IMD Step down Homes (4 homes, 16 beds)
- IMD Intensive Transition Services

Safety Net Continuum

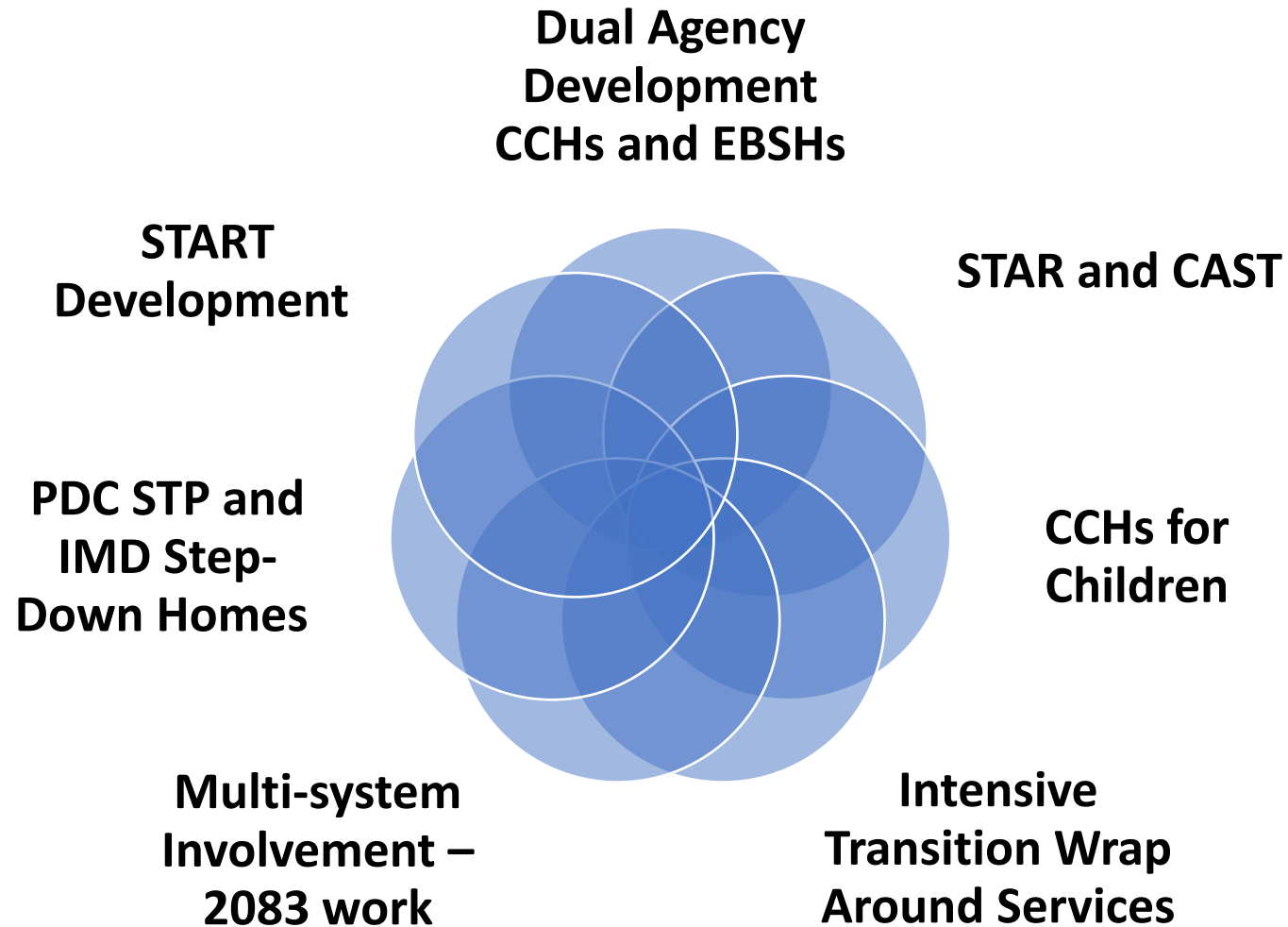

Safety Net Continuum

- Crisis Prevention and Intervention
 - Expansion of START
- Increase Community Capacity
 - CCHs for Children
 - EBSH DESP for individuals from STP (5 homes, 20 bed capacity total)
- Child and Youth System of Care Implementation
 - Regional Center AB 2083 Coordinators
 - Dual Agency EBSHs and CCHs for Youth
- Specialized Caseload Ratio for Individuals with Complex Needs
