



Recommendations for Improving PIP and CIE Incentives

- 1. Talk about internships as a job, not a program
- 2. Simplify and streamline administrative tasks for providers
- 3. Incentivize employers to provide job coaching
- 4. Utilize providers as consultants to businesses and employers
- 5. Engage and inform families early to expect and prepare their child for employment
- 6. Communicate the value of the PIP and successful employment through success stories and social media

Overview of Subminimum Wage Pilot Program

Service Model Pilot

- \$8.3 million one-time funding
- Pilot for individuals exiting work activity programs or high school
- The service model will focus on:
 - The interests of individuals through individualized discussions and planning, leading to discovery and identification of career pathways
 - Competitive Integrated Employment
 - Postsecondary Education
 - Career pathway for individuals exiting a work activity program or high school

Required Elements of the Pilot Program

- Be person centered and time limited services
- Considers evidence based or promising practices to eliminate barriers
- Requires service providers report on defined outcome measures







Work Activity Program Population FY 2019/20 – FY 2021/22




