## SUBJECT: ELECTRONIC VISIT VERIFICATION PROVIDER COMPLIANCE

In accordance with <u>Section 12006(a) of the 21st Century Cures Act</u> (Cures Act), states are required to implement Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) for personal care services and home health care services that require an in-home visit by a provider. EVV has been implemented for personal care services and home health care services.

By June 1, 2023, regional center providers of personal care and home health care services subject to EVV are required to be transmitting Cures Act compliant data to the state's EVV system either via CalEVV, free to use state supplied EVV system, or via an alternate EVV system of the provider's choosing which meets the state's requirements.
