Career Pathways to Competitive Integrated Employment Pilot



Career Pathway Navigator

Develops Person Centered

Career Plan

Assists and trains
consumers/family members
on career options,
navigating regional center
and generic services to
meet needs

Provides interpreters, translation and plain language materials

Monthly reassessment, expedites changes to plan

Assists individuals to obtain benefits planning and financial empowerment tools

Quarterly reporting on data on milestones achieved, employment outcomes and annual progress report

Career Pathway Navigator Qualifications

Bachelors-level degree in human services with three-years of experience in the field of developmental disabilities service systems <u>or</u> an Associates-level degree with 5 years of experience

The Career Pathway Navigator must be certified in both:

- Person-centered thinking/planning and
- Association of Community Rehabilitation Educators (ACRE) Certificate with an emphasis on Customized Employment <u>or</u> Association of People Supporting Employment First (APSE) Certified Employment Support Professional (CESP) Certification
- Must be knowledgeable of the service delivery systems including the regional center and generic services for community integration and employment

Customized Employment

- Includes Customized Employment services such as discovery, job search planning, job development and negotiation, and post employment support based on individual needs
- Long term business relationships established
 - Identifies employer needs and presents solutions
 - Negotiates a customized position for individual
- Post Customized Employment placement support

Customized Employment, Cont.

- Long term supports
 - Works with employer to develop natural supports and/or
 - Transitions individual to individual supported employment
- Includes self-employment, micro-enterprises, gig-based economy
- 18-24 Months

Customized Employment Specialist Qualifications

- Associates-Level degree in a human services field and two-years of experience or high school diploma (or equivalent) with two-years of experience with customized employment
- ACRE Certification with an emphasis on customized employment or CESP Certification
- Experience with business engagement, job analysis, discovery, systematic instruction, and positive behavioral supports

Customized Employment Specialist Qualifications, Cont.

- Proficiency in the languages of the consumers supported is preferred
- Career Pathways to CIE providers shall provide training and coaching to Career Pathway Navigator, Customized Employment Specialist, and staff by a qualified subject matter expert on the implementation of Customized Employment services to assure proficiency in the delivery of services
- Exceptions to the minimum qualifications, along with the justification, shall be submitted to the regional center for the Department of Developmental Services' determination
