SUBJECT: NURSING POLICIES & PROCEDURES/COMPETENCY TRAINING FOR

STAFF IN THE ADULT RESIDENTIAL FACILITIES FOR PERSONS WITH SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS (ARFPSHN) & GROUP HOMES FOR

CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS (GHCSHN)

The purpose of this memorandum is for the Department of Developmental Services (DDS) to inform regional centers (RC) of the requirement that all ARFPSHNs and GHCSHNs must have written nursing policies and procedures (NPPs), accompanied by corresponding return demonstration competency trainings, to address the intensive support and special health care needs of individuals served at the home.

Written NPPs and competency trainings are essential to ensure staff are well prepared to support the needs of medically fragile individuals and to comply with California Code of Regulations, Title 22, Section 80065 (a), "Facility personnel shall be competent to provide the services necessary to meet individual client needs and shall, at all times, be employed in numbers necessary to meet such needs."

An ARFPSHN or GHCSHN approved as part of a RC's Community Placement Plan must have a program design that includes written NPPs and competency trainings prior to Department certification. RCs should ensure NPPs, and competency trainings are based on current best practice standards and include cited resources. Once certified, NPP and competency training additions and revisions must be reviewed and approved by the RC and DDS.
