Criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Have a developmental delay of at least 25% in one or more areas of cognitive, communication, social or emotional, adaptive, or physical and motor development including vision and hearing -or- Have an established risk condition of known etiology, with a high probability of resulting in delayed development -or- At high risk of having a substantial developmental disability due to a combination of biomedical risk factors of which are diagnosed by qualified personnel 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Disability is not solely physical in nature Significant functional limitations in at least 2 major life activities: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Self-care Receptive and expressive language Learning Mobility Self-direction 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Intellectual disability, autism, epilepsy, cerebral palsy, and/or other disability that closely resembles ID and/or individual requires similar services Originates prior to age 18, is lifelong "Substantial disability" - significant functional limitations in 3 or more areas: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Self-care Receptive and expressive language Learning Mobility Self-direction Capacity for independent living Economic self-sufficiency
