The criteria for determining eligibility for infants and toddlers for Early Start services is specified in <u>Section 95014 of the California Government</u> <u>Code</u>. Eligibility criteria for Lanterman Act and Provisional Lanterman Act services are specified in <u>Sections 4512(a)(1) and 4512(a)(2)</u> and of the <u>California Welfare and Institutions Code</u>.
