SUBJECT: REIMBURSEMENT FOR EARLY START PROVIDER TRAINING – ADDITIONAL TRAININGS ELIGIBLE FOR REIMBURSEMENT

In correspondence dated <u>January 30, 2023</u> and <u>October 13, 2023</u>, the Department of Developmental Services notified regional centers regarding the availability of funds to reimburse providers for trainings, and the time period to spend the funds. The purpose of this letter is to notify regional centers of the expansion of permissible training topics and the updated timeline to submit training requests for the Early Start Provider Training initiative, funded through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) of 2021.

Permissible training topics have been expanded to include the following:

- Family engagement practices in early intervention; and
- Coursework for Associate of Science degrees and licensure for Speech-Language Pathology, Occupational Therapy, and Physical Therapy.

While the cost for training fees and/or staff time to attend training are reimbursable; staff time toward completing coursework for the Associate of Science degrees is not reimbursable.

The Department is requesting that regional centers disseminate information about this funding opportunity to their Early Start vendor community. If there are any questions regarding this correspondence, please e-mail <u>earlystart@dds.ca.gov</u>.
