SUBJECT: 2024 REIMBURSEMENT RATE FOR IN-HOME RESPITE AGENCY WORKER

TRAVEL COSTS

The mileage reimbursement rate for California state employees using their personal vehicle for authorized state business increased from \$.655/mile to \$.67/mile, effective January 1, 2024. The 2024 reimbursement rate can be found at the following link:

This change affects in-home respite agency providers claiming worker travel costs as a supplemental cost in accordance with Welfare & Institutions Code section 4690.2(b)(6), "The rate methodology developed by the department may include a supplemental amount of reimbursement for travel costs of respite workers using their private vehicles to and from and between respite sites. The supplemental amount shall be the minimum rate for travel reimbursement for state employees."
