## Section 100 Family Cost Participation Program Repeal

## Written Statement Explanation of Changes

Pursuant to title 1, division 1, chapter 1, article 2, section 100(b)(1) of the California Code of Regulations (CCR), the Department of Developmental Services (Department) hereby submits this written statement explaining why the proposed repeal to title 17 does not materially alter any requirement, right, responsibility, condition, prescription or other regulatory element of any CCR provision.

The Budget Act of 2023 enacted Assembly Bill (AB) 162 (Chapter 47, Statutes of 2024), whereby Welfare and Institutions Code (WIC) section 4783, was repealed, effective July 2, 2024. WIC, section 4783 established the Family Cost Participation Program and authorized the Department of Developmental Services (Department), to implement and make specific the Family Cost Participation regulations. The Department proposes a change without regulatory effect that would repeal subchapter 2.5, Family Cost Participation, articles 1, 2, 3, and 4, and sections 50243, 50245, 50247, 50249, 50251, 50253, 50255, 50257, 50259, 50261, 50262, 50263, 50265, and 50267 of title 17, California Code of Regulations (CCR).

The proposed repeal is a change without regulatory effect, consistent with the provisions of title 1, CCR, section 100(a)(2), deleting a regulatory provision for which all statutory or constitutional authority has been repealed.
