



Rate Reform FAQs about ILS/SLS/PA

Q1. What is the maximum allowable hours for Independent Living Services (ILS) per month?

A1. The maximum number of hours for ILS is 80 hours per month. If an individual requires additional training, the regional center Executive Director may allow for an exemption.

Q2. Can an individual receive Independent Living Services (ILS) while living in their parent's home?

A2. Yes, individuals are allowed to receive ILS while living in their parent's home or their own home.

Q3. Who can receive Supported Living Services (SLS) services?

A3. An individual 18 years of age or older and is living in a home that is not the place of residence of their parent or conservator may receive SLS.

Q4. As a Supported Living Services (SLS) provider, are administrative costs for SLS billed separately?

A4. Administrative costs for SLS services are now built into the rate for service code 896. Service code 894 will no longer be used.
