What to Know

The Regional Center Performance Measures (RCPM) were created to set clear standards and goals to show what good services look like. They help regional centers know what goals to reach so individuals get better support and care. Regional center participation in RCPM is voluntary.

The RCPM has six focus areas:

- Early Start
- Employment
- Equity and Cultural Competency
- Individual and Family Experience and Satisfaction
- Person-Centered Services Planning and
- Service Coordination and Regional Center Operation.

What's Changing

This letter provides details to regional centers about changes to the RCPM goals for the 2025–26 fiscal year:

- 6 goals are new because the Department wants to show more ways to help improve services in other areas
- 7 goals ended because they are no longer needed or are part of the law regional centers must follow.
