If Early Start...

Improves conditions and incentives for providing high quality Early Intervention (EI), and

Builds its infrastructure to support high quality implementation and data analysis to:

- Standardize the IFSP and goal expectations, and
- Provide Technical Assistance, Professional Development, and coaching to build the capacity of staff, families, and the community to understand and practice high quality EI, specifically to:
 - Uniformly conduct family-directed assessments,
 - Develop high quality IFSPs,
 - Coach families to help their children,
 - Monitor goal progress consistently

Programs and staff will...

- 1) Uniformly conduct high quality family-directed assessments,
- 2) Develop high quality IFSPs,
- 3) Implement family coaching universally and consistent with recommended practice, and
- 4) Monitor progress validly and consistently

Then...

More families receiving early intervention will help their children develop and learn.
