



# Service Code Crosswalk

As recommended in the 2019 Rate Study, rate reform includes standardization of service requirements and service codes. Each service description is tied to a service code, with subcodes for all associated variations. Some service codes will remain unchanged, others will be adjusted to incorporate multiple service codes or subcodes, and some will be phased out.

**Below is a list of potential rate models for transitioning service codes. This list highlights common service transitions but does not include all options and other service codes may be used.** Regional Centers and providers are encouraged to work together to identify the rate model that best reflects the services currently being provided.
