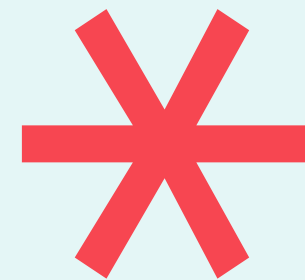

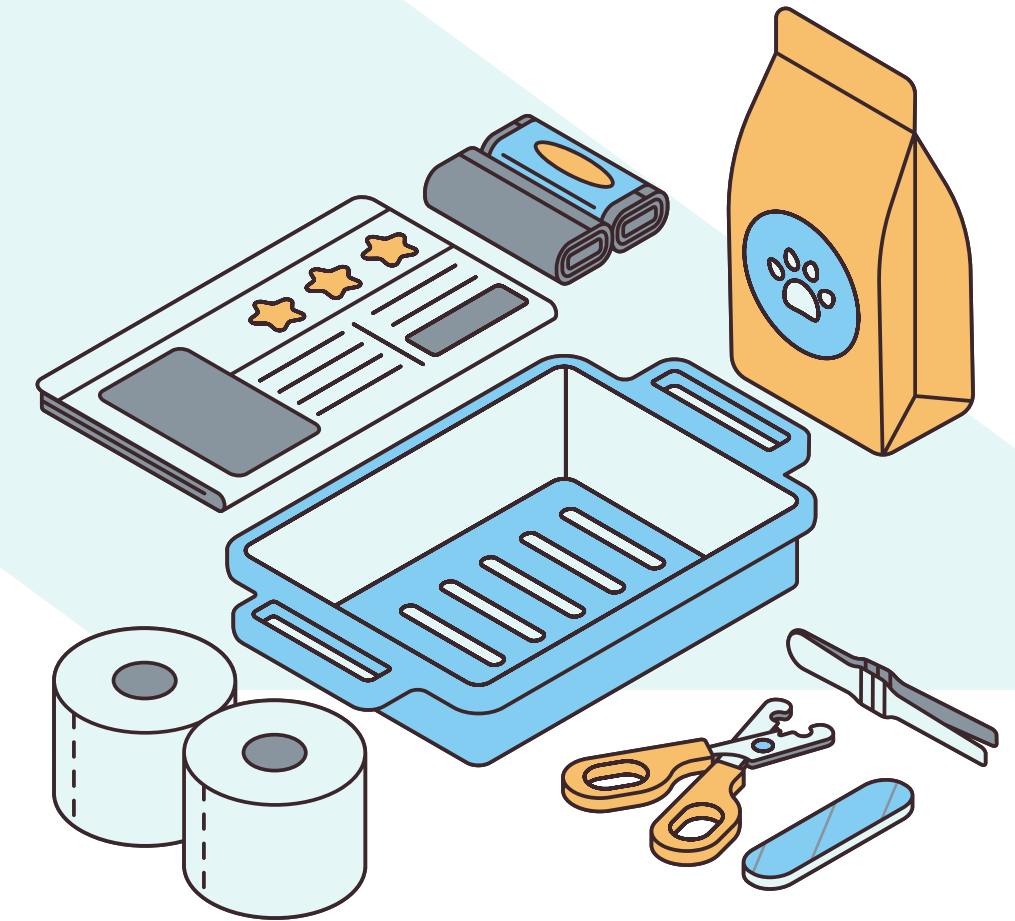

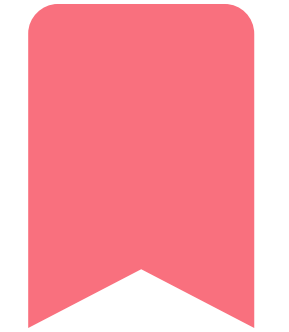

Everbridge

Wireless Emergency Alerts (WEAs)

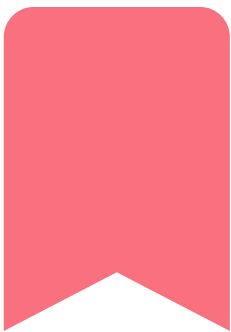
Check with your cellular carrier to ensure your device can receive them.
